Guidelines

Senior Spotlight is a time where we honor our senior class in the orchestra program. This is an opportunity for you to be recognized in front of the orchestra program as our most dedicated and experienced members of the program. Senior Spotlights will be in the form of a video/slideshow with voice overs.

Follow the guidelines below when constructing your Senior Spotlight:

- Senior Spotlights will be recorded via the apps on the next page (use your phone's voice memo). It can be your voice or a friend's voice that reads your Senior Spotlight. If you are able, please create a short video of your own through the apps listed on the next page.
- The writing of your Senior Spotlight should describe a little bit about your background (i.e., "I was born in suburbs of the modern suburban jungle...aka Marietta, GA.") It can also include your favorite memories of being in orchestra and/ or favorite memories of your friends in orchestra. You can end it with giving thanks/ shout-outs to the people that helped you get this far (i.e., Your parents, friends, etc.)
- The Senior Spotlight can be between 30-45 seconds in length.
- You can use Flipgrid, Splice, iMovie, or any other video/photo app to make a short movie.
- Feel free to use video or photos or a combination of both.
- Please be mindful that parents and underclassman will be present. Please keep all information (words/photo/video/etc.) appropriate for all ages.
- All videos/media can be placed on a flash drive and given to Mr. Mori or upload to a cloud storage (i.e., google drive) and send the link to: Koji.mori@cobbk12.org
